WITH
STIPULATION

CONSENT AGREEMENT

IT IS AGREED by the South Dakota Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners (SDBMOE or the Board) and Amanda Schemmel (Ms. Schemmel), applicant for medical assistant registration, as follows:

1. Registration status: Ms. Schemmel does not hold a South Dakota registration. She is an applicant for registration as a medical assistant.

2. Admission/Facts: Ms. Schemmel admits to the following facts:
 - a. That a South Dakota medical assistant registration is a privilege, not a right or an entitlement.

 - b. That Ms. Schemmel, as the applicant, bears the burden of proving that she is fit to practice in a competent, safe, professional and respectful manner as a medical assistant.

 - c. That Ms. Schemmel submitted an initial application for medical assistant registration, and she admitted to juvenile delinquency, and misdemeanor offenses as an adult which include:
 - i. False Report to Authorities / Fail to Maintain Financial Responsibility
 - ii. Impersonation To Deceive Law Enforcement Officer / Displaying Another's License as One's Own / Possession of Alcohol by Minor
 - iii. Petty Theft – 1st Degree

 - d. That Ms. Schemmel's application was placed under investigation due to her admissions, and the Board's Investigative Review Panel requested that she attend an informal meeting on April 13, 2010.

 - e. That Ms. Schemmel's background contained a significant history of alcohol use.

 - f. That Ms. Schemmel's initial application form was insufficient, and because she failed to satisfactorily explain her affirmative answers, several amendments were required; as a result, the application process was significantly delayed.

STIPULATION

Ms. Schemmel agrees that her registration to practice as a medical assistant shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a. It is strongly suggested that any use of alcohol be conducted in a responsible, safe and legal manner.
- b. A copy of this Consent Agreement will become a permanent part of the official file.
- c. Should any future incidents arise that involve unprofessional conduct, including but not limited to infractions of the law, reconsideration of this matter will occur and likely result in further disciplinary action.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that this Consent Agreement with Stipulation shall take effect immediately and is a public record of the Board and the State of South Dakota. The State may provide a copy of it to any person or entity, professional licensing board, federal, state, or local government, or other entity making an inquiry which is acceptable to the Board. The action taken by the Board in this Consent Agreement will be published on the Board's web site and any other entity deemed appropriate by the Board.

Ms. Schemmel has unconditionally accepted this Consent Agreement with Stipulation by affixing her signature to this document.

STIPULATION


