STIPULATION

It is stipulated by the South Dakota Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners (Board) and Austin Stage (Mr. Stage) as follows:

1. Licensure status: Mr. Stage is an applicant for licensure in South Dakota.
2. Admission/Facts: Mr. Stage admits to the following facts:
 - a. That Mr. Stage failed to update his address which caused a significant delay in the licensure process of his application.
 - b. That he did not disclose a Disciplinary Probation during his Respiratory Therapy Program.

AGREEMENT

It is agreed that the Respiratory Care Practitioner license issued to Austin Stage, shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Mr. Stage shall keep the Board informed with his correct contact information.
2. He shall complete accurate and timely renewals.

It is further agreed that this Stipulation and Agreement shall take effect immediately and is a public record of the Board and the State of South Dakota and will be published and reported as deemed necessary. Further, Mr. Stage understands he has the right to consult with an attorney who is licensed in South Dakota, and if no attorney is present or signs this agreement, he waives said right.

AGREEMENT


