MEDICAL EXAMINERS LICENSE #3843 * ORDER OF REVOCATION
ISSUED TO GUIDO SPANGHER, M.D. *
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WHEREAS, Guido Spangher, M.D., is the holder of license #3843 of the South Dakota State Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as Board, and

WHEREAS, the South Dakota State Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter herein, and

WHEREAS, the Board is in receipt of certain information which evidences that Guido Spangher, M.D., suffers from a chemical dependency, and that such constitutes unprofessional conduct on the part of Guido Spangher, M.D., and would affect the practice of Guido Spangher, M.D., and constitutes grounds for cancellation, revocation, suspension or limitation of any South Dakota license to practice medicine issued to Guido Spangher, M.D., and

WHEREAS, Guido Spangher, M.D., on November 27, 2000, requested that the Board accept his voluntary surrender of


license #3843 for an indefinite period of time because of his chemical dependency, and

WHEREAS, the Board has accepted the voluntary surrender of license #3843 issued to Guido Spangher, M.D., due to his chemical dependency.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to the request of Guido Spangher, M.D., and the Board's finding that Guido Spangher, M.D., suffers from a chemical dependency, that the Board ACCEPTS VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of license #3843 issued to Guido Spangher, M.D., for an indefinite time period, and it is further ORDERED that license #3843 is hereby indefinitely REVOKED.
