BOARD OF MEDICAL AND OSTEOPATHIC * LETTER OF REPRIMAND
EXAMINERS LICENSE #1128 ISSUED * WITH REMEDIATION
TO JENIFFER SPRECKELS-MCMANUS *
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WHEREAS, Jeniffer Spreckels-McManus, PT, is the holder of physical therapy license #1128 of the South Dakota Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter herein, and

WHEREAS, the Board received notification that Ms. McManus had been terminated from her employment as a physical therapist in Chamberlain, SD, for unprofessional and unethical conduct, and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2006, Board Investigator H. Adrian Mohr, and Investigation Coordinator Jane Phalen, met informally with Ms. McManus wherein she admitted to her unprofessional and unethical conduct, and

WHEREAS, Ms. McManus voluntarily signed a Statement of Agreement for Informal Settlement that a Letter of Reprimand

with Remediation would be presented to the Board at the next meeting, and

WHEREAS, it was explained that the Board has discretion in whether or not they will approve the Order of Letter of Reprimand with Remediation, and

WHEREAS, the conditions of the Order to be presented to the Board include:

1. A conditional renewal of South Dakota physical therapy license #1128 until April 1, 2007. Further licensure contingent upon Board members review and determination regarding this informal agreement at the Board Meeting to be held on March 21, 2007.

2. Completion of a course in ethics by June 1, 2007. Submit the specifics of the course to the Board prior to enrollment in order to obtain approval of the course. After receiving approval, to enroll, complete, and provide proof of completion, and submit a report regarding the focus of the ethics course.

3. No further violations of any nature for a period of two years.

4. The LETTER OF REPRIMAND WITH REMEDIATION is a matter of public record and will be reported to all agencies as deemed necessary by the Board, and in compliance with state and federal

statutes and regulations, and will be posted on the SDBMOE
Disciplinary Website for 2007, and

WHEREAS, Ms. McManus understands that she has waived
her rights to due process in regard to this matter. However, if
the Board does not approve the Agreement, she is entitled to all
due process rights as provided for by law, and

WHEREAS, the Board approved this Agreement for Informal
Settlement and Letter of Reprimand with Remediation.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that license #1128 issued
to Jeniffer Spreckels-McManus, PT, is REPRIMANDED for
unprofessional and unethical conduct, and that

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that if Jeniffer Spreckels-McManus,
PT, engages in unprofessional or unethical conduct in the future
the Board may impose disciplinary action as they deem
appropriate without the necessity of a hearing.
