BOARD OF MEDICAL AND OSTEOPATHIC \* AND LETTER  
EXAMINERS SUSPENDED LICENSE #0835 \* OF REPRIMAND  
FOR LEA ANN KROG TATRO, EMT I/85 \*

WHEREAS, Lea Ann Krog Tatro was the holder of emergency medical technician intermediate/85 (EMT I/85) license #0835 of the South Dakota Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners, hereinafter referred to as the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter herein, and

WHEREAS, Ms. Krog Tatro allowed her EMT I/85 license to suspend due to non-renewal in July of 2007, and

WHEREAS, everything contained in the original Stipulation and Letter of Reprimand shall remain, and that agreement is AMENDED in the following particulars:

a) No ethics courses for EMT's could be located; however, the members of the Advanced Life Support Committee advised the Board that there exists a Code of Conduct for EMTs.

b) The Board directed that Ms. Krog Tatro meet with a joint committee composed of the members of the Board's Investigative Review Panel and the members of the Advanced Life Support Advisory Committee, and if the meeting was determined to be successful by the joint committee, that her license be reinstated with recommendations from the committee.

c)After the March 17, 2009,meeting with Ms. Krog Tatro, the joint committee agreed that her license could be reinstated, and they recommended that she shall provide a written report addressing the topics of professionalism, personal responsibility, and the EMT Code of Conduct.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that license #0835 will be reinstated to Lea Ann Krog Tatro, EMT I/85, with the condition that she shall submit the written report as noted above, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there are any future instances of unprofessional conduct, of if she does not fulfill the conditions of this agreement, the Board shall impose further disciplinary action as they deem appropriate, including the possibility of permanent revocation of her license, without the necessity of a hearing.
