

**MA SUPERVISION REGISTRATION FORM UPDATED 12/7/16**

- SDCL 36-9B-1<sup>i</sup> provides that a medical assistant must be directly supervised by a licensed physician, licensed physician assistant or a licensed advanced practice nurse.
- Both the medical assistant (MA) and the supervising provider must be licensed in South Dakota and have a board approved practice agreement on file with the board office before seeing patients.
- The terms of this agreement shall remain in effect unless the agreement is terminated in writing by either party.

<sup>i</sup> 36-9B-1. Medical assistant defined. For the purposes of this chapter, a medical assistant is a professional multiskilled person who assists in all aspects of medical practice under the responsibility and direct supervision of a person licensed to practice medicine in the State of South Dakota. A medical assistant assists with patient care management, executes administrative and clinical procedures, and performs managerial and supervisory functions over unlicensed personnel.
